



## Producer VFD Checklist

- ✓ Review the *JBS United Veterinary Feed Directive for Distributors* brochure for VFD information
- ✓ Review the *VFD Resource Center* ([JBSUnited.com/VFD](http://JBSUnited.com/VFD)) and periodically check the site for updates
- ✓ Review the *Veterinary-Client-Patient Relationship* (VCPR) requirements outlined in the VFD Producer brochure
- ✓ Develop lines of communication with your veterinarian and JBS United Account Manager to maximize animal health, nutrition and to ensure on-time service
- ✓ Know which medications and medicated feeds are currently used, and which products will require a VFD
- ✓ Develop a plan for medications and medicated feeds that are in the mill, bin or feeder on January 1, 2017
- ✓ Develop a plan for medications and medicated feeds that are remaining onsite after a VFD expires
- ✓ Know which JBS United location(s) is servicing your farm(s)
- ✓ Know which medications and medicated feeds are floor-stocked at the location(s) servicing your farm(s)
- ✓ Upload production sites into the *Global Vet Link* site (if currently using e-VFDs) by contacting GVL Sales – 515-817-5703 or GVL Support – 515-817-5704
- ✓ Develop a recordkeeping system to maintain VFDs for 2 years
- ✓ Comply with the VFD distributor requirements if you manufacture/sell VFD feed to other producers
- ✓ Prepare for regulatory inspections to occur unannounced and designate a person who is authorized to accompany the inspector
